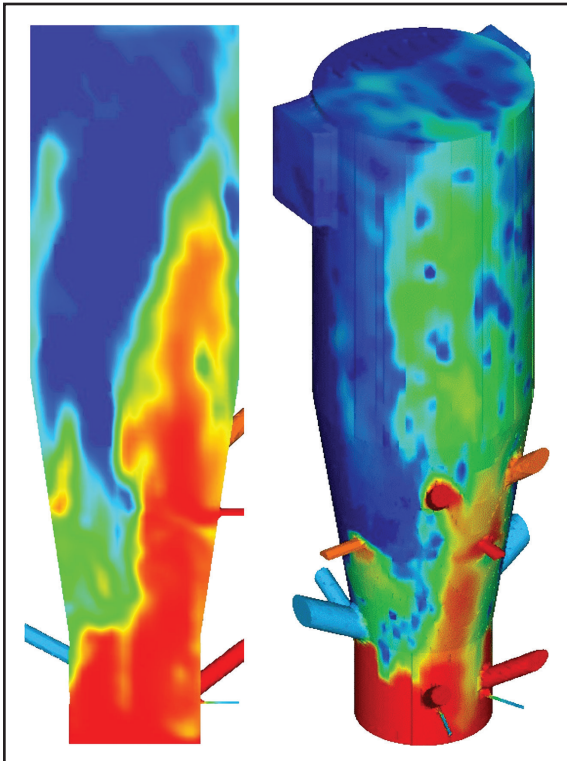
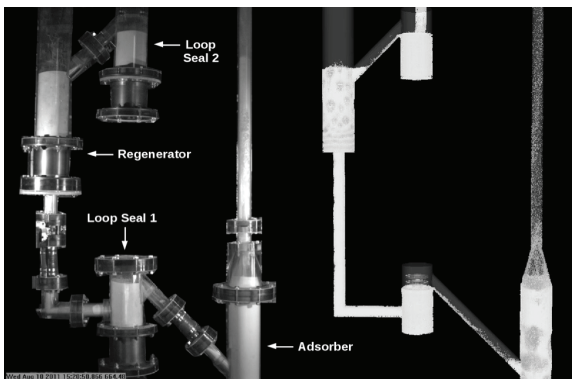

Improve the operation of your CFB combustor

- Coal composition details (proximate analysis)
